Computer Note:



On or about March 2002, I phoned Mr. Burgess to gain further information as to his leaving the employment of HAWL.

I have attached the notes made during that telephone conversion. (See Attached)

From talking with Mr. Burgess, it appears, the reason he resigned, HAWL attempted to force him to approve the construction of an Elevator and paving HAWL's spillway.

TO the EDITOR:

To inform HAWL members of the reasons for my recent resignation, I hereby submit text of my letter to the Club.

"When asked to monitor and enforce a standard building code for our community in 1994, I took pride, both then and now, in having been sincere and forthright in upholding the code regulations and quality of life that this club deserves. My objectives were only the betterment of our area and the safe, sanitary and secure feeling our members expressed to me that they felt under my responsibility.

I have been extremely disappointed in the change of attitude of late with the relaxation of any commitment to code regulations or enforcement. I feel the quality of our community will deteriorate as the club's management culture diminishes responsibilities of our standards.

It is with deep regret and sadness that I resign my subcontractor status as the code enforcement officer as of November 15. I refuse to affix my name or seal on substandard policies.

Effective immediately, Hide-A-Way Lake Club can no longer have the privilege of using my licenses and certifications for any code enforcement or environmental concerns.
